#### OVERVIEW:

Do you love the great outdoors? Enjoy the Florida sunshine? Become a resident volunteer with us this spring at Hugh Taylor Birch State Park. Nestled between sunny Fort Lauderdale beach and the Intracoastal Waterway this cozy barrier island has been called the "Central Park of Fort Lauderdale". We are looking for individuals who love the great outdoors, enjoy working with others, and are willing to work outside during the spring or summer months.

**Requested Timeframe:** We are looking for volunteers who are willing to stay with us **April – July 2022** and **July – October 2022**.

**Volunteer Requirements/Hours:** You will be required to work a minimum of 20 hours per week per site as a resident volunteer and work well with others in a team environment, in exchange you will be provided an RV site with an electrical, sewage, and water hookup in cozy Volunteer Village for your stay with us.

**Duties and Responsibilities:** As an integral member of the Hugh Taylor Birch State Park team you will work alongside staff and other volunteers in an outdoor environment making an important impact, whether it be through park maintenance or visitor services. We are looking for people who are willing to perform maintenance tasks such as mowing, weed-eating, trash-pickup, special projects and helping to assist park staff in their various daily duties. We are looking for enthusiastic hardworking people who are willing to work mornings, and possibly evenings and weekends if necessary. As a resident volunteer you will have the opportunity to work on a wide variety of park projects that may include carpentry, plumbing, tiling, camp maintenance and other similar hands-on outdoor projects. We are also looking for someone who would be available to work in the park's ranger station, welcoming visitors, answering questions and providing information about all the amenities that the park has to offer.

**Required Attire:** Volunteer uniform. Green volunteer t-shirt or polo (provided). Tan khaki shorts or slakes with black shoes (not provided).
