

red on yellow - kills a fellow". The importance of this rhyme is to specify if red touches black you are dealing with the harmless Scarlet King Snake, but if red touches yellow, run, because you are dealing with the Coral Snake. This great rhyme helps adults and kids to not only avoid a dangerous animal, but also identify when there is no threat, so both critter and human can continue on their way peacefully. The Scarlet Snake is most commonly found in the southeastern and eastern portions on the United States. They are usually found in pine Flatwoods, hydric hammocks, mesic pine-oak forests and a variety of suburban habitats; in spring, for example, you could even encounter one in a swimming pool! The maximum recorded length is about 27 inches, but are more commonly between 16 to 20 inches in maturity.

HUGH TAYLOR BIRCH INDUCTED INTO THE WALK OF FAME



On Saturday, May 23, 2015, Hugh Taylor Birch was recognized as the Father of Fort Lauderdale Beach for his donation of almost three-miles of open beach to the City of Fort Lauderdale-giving the City its economic engine: Tourism. Of course, he was also recognized for donating the 180 acres as a state park giving Fort Lauderdale a very special green space in the midst of a rapidly developing area. Hugh Taylor Birch's nephew and only living relative, Birch Willey, accepted on behalf of "Uncle Hugh". Be sure and visit the Walk of Fame which is across from the Elbo Room located on the sidewalk by the wave wall. Also inducted were: Ina Lee, Travel Host owner and Friends' board member; Ron O'Brien, Olympic Diving Coach; and Tim Schiavonne, owner of the World Famous Parrot. Past Iuminaries include: Wayne Huizenga and Jimmy and Chris Evert.

WEEKLY AT THE PARK

Come and meet the park rangers:

Every Friday & Saturday Live Animal Presentation 1:00 pm

A Live Animal Presentation is held at the Beach Gate Entrance - Park Rangers offer a Live Animal Presentation with our park's very own resident critters!

First Friday of each month: Mangrove Habitat Walk 10:30 am

This 1.5-mile walk guides guests past the famous Gopher Tortoise habitat, through the Pavilion 1 & 2 area and into the park's extensive mangrove habitat.

Second Friday of each month: Mid-Trail Walk 10:30 am

This 2-mile walk gives guests the historical overview of the park and focuses on the importance of balanced ecosystems in South Florida.

Third Friday of each month: Beach & Coastal Dune Lake 10:30 am

This 1-mile walk guides guests past one of the park's unique fresh-water ecosystems, the Coastal Dune Lake, and informs guests about the formation and evolution of Barrier Island systems.

Fourth Friday of each month: Beach Hammock Trail Walk 10:30 am

This 1-mile walk guides guests into one of the last residual Tropical Hardwood Hammock (Maritime Forest) habitats in Broward County.

Monthly close to full moon Full Moon Mangrove Tour 8:30 am

This approximately 3 hour ranger-guided canoe ride takes you into the Mangrove habitat area. Some restrictions apply please visit our website for more information.
